

Candidate for School Board

To run as a candidate for the Board of Education in the November General Election:

Your petition must be filed with the County Clerk's Office, Election Division, 100 University Ct., Blackwood NJ 08012, before 4:00 p.m. on or before the last Monday of July proceeding the November School Election.

Nomination Petitions are available at the County Clerk's Office

Election Division, 100 University Ct., Blackwood NJ 08012, during normal business hours or can be downloaded below.

Nomination Petition and Instructions for November School Board Candidates

Pursuant to P.L. 2018, c.20, School Board Candidates are permitted to circulate petitions jointly and be bracketed together on the ballot. Candidates may also choose to have a three word, nonpolitical designation appear on the ballot that conveys principles that the candidate represents. The addition of bracketing and the use of a slogan will not change the layout of the ballot. Candidates will continue to occupy a single column and be arranged by the results of the draw. Any bracketed candidates will be drawn by their slogan and may be found above, below or between individual candidates based on the results of the draw— bracketed candidates will be kept together within the same contest. All candidates, individual or bracketed, will have their own voting box/oval and will be tallied separately.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR NOMINATING PETITION FOR ANNUAL SCHOOL ELECTIONS

This information sheet is not meant to encompass all of the statutory and constitutional requirements for filing petitions but is to be used only as a guide. If you have any additional questions, you should seek legal counsel.

1. Completed nominating petitions shall be filed with the Camden County Clerk's Office not later than 4:00 pm on the last Monday of July. **Petitions are accepted:**

* It is highly recommended that petitions are filed in person; however, if you choose to mail the petition, it must be **received** prior to the deadline - postmarks are not acceptable.

2. At least ten (10) signatures shall be required to any petition.
3. The candidate's name, address and office he/she is seeking must be on the petition before circulation. **DO NOT CIRCULATE BLANK PETITIONS.**
4. More than one candidate can appear on the same petition. Full Term and Unexpired Terms are acceptable on the same petition. However, if one office is successfully challenged, the petition becomes invalid for all of the candidates.
5. The circulator of the petition **MUST WITNESS ALL SIGNATURES. DO NOT PASS PETITION TO A SECOND CIRCULATOR - USE A NEW PETITION.**
6. The circulator of the petition must execute the affidavit in Section C. **AFFIDAVIT MUST BE NOTARIZED.**
7. Each candidate **MUST FILE AN OATH OF ALLEGIANCE WITH THEIR PETITIONS. OATH MUST BE NOTARIZED.**
8. The Camden County Clerk's Office cannot notarize documents that are filed in our office.
9. Any registered voter at the time of signing can sign the petition.
10. Each registered voter can only sign one time for the same candidate and cannot sign more petitions than candidates to be nominated.
11. A candidate can sign his/her own petition and be the circulator.
12. Pursuant to P.L. 2018, ch. 66, all candidates for any public elective office must include a function e-mail address on their petition of nomination.

QUALIFICATIONS - Candidates filing a nominating petition for board membership must meet the following qualifications:

- a citizen of the United States of America
- at least 18 (eighteen) years of age to qualify for office
- able to read and write
- a resident of the municipality from which he/she is to be elected for at least one year preceding the date of the election
- not disqualified as a voter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1
- a registered voter in the district
- not convicted of a disqualifying crime pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1

No board of education member shall be directly or indirectly involved in any contract with, or claim against, the board.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Within 30 days of election or appointment to the board, a member must undergo a **criminal history background investigation** through the New Jersey Department of Education.
- The School Ethics Act and nepotism legislation impact the ability of board members who have relatives working in the school district to act in areas such as personnel and collective negotiations. Please consult your board secretary for details.
- Two or more candidates for any given term of office may notify in writing the County Clerk, at least seven days before the drawing date that they wish to have their names with their chosen designation, if any, bracketed together, so that their names and designation, if any, are selected as a group at the drawing and their names and designation are printed together on the ballot. The candidates shall determine among themselves the order in which their names are to appear within the bracket prior to so notifying.
